Clarification - Helmets etc...

G'day Nic,

Sorry, not only have we confused you but we confused ourselves, particularly with Snell helmets.

Helmets, Posts and HANS device(s)

The new Motorsport Australia Helmet rule changes apply to the following:

- Helmets (Snell)
 - Tether anchors (Posts on the helmets)

The Helmets

Helmets must comply with Standard A, which is Circuit Racing.

The older Snell SA2010 and SAH2010 helmets are NOT APPROVED Standard A helmets.

The Snell SA2020 and SA2015 helmets are APPROVED Standard A helmets, but must have the correct Tether anchors (Posts), see below.



Tether Anchors (Posts)

Tether anchors on the helmets must also comply with Standard A.

Tether Anchors on the helmets must have FIA 8858-2010 stamped on them.

The older FIA 8858-2002 style posts are NOT approved for use on Standard A helmets.



This is the older FIA 8858-2002 Tether Anchor (Post) up close.

The older FIA 8858-2002 style posts have a straight bladed nut and have the number FIA 8858-2002 on them.

The numbers are stamped onto the black washer. They are really small, but can be read.



Whichever compliant helmet you have, you must have FIA 8858-2010 Tether Anchors.

These are pictures of the **APPROVED FIA 8858-2010** anchors.

They have a hex nut and the number FIA 8858-2010 engraved on the metal washer.



The good news is that the old tether anchors can be replaced.

You can purchase them from motorsport suppliers.

Talk to them about replacement.
